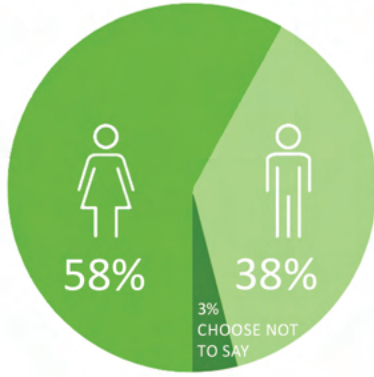

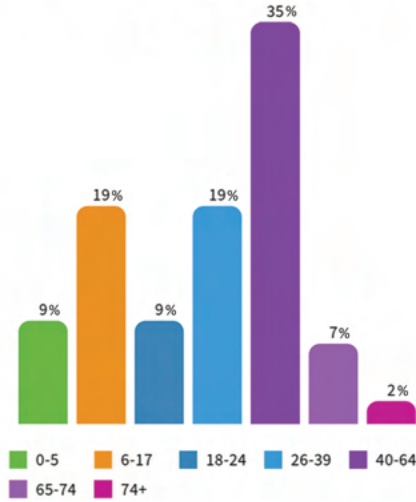

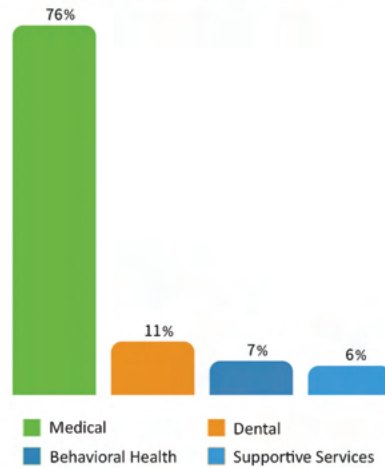

## UMMA HEALTH'S TRANSFORMATIONAL YEAR



# WHO WE ARE

In the aftermath of the 1992 Los Angeles civil unrest, a group of visionary medical and graduate students from the University of California, Los Angeles, took a stand. They chose to channel their talents and skills into a force for healing, addressing the profound social, emotional, and economic rifts laid bare by the unrest. Today, **UMMA stands as a beacon of hope and healing**: a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) and a recognized Patient Centered Medical Home (PCMH). Our dedicated team of **120 employees** proudly delivers a comprehensive range of integrated healthcare services, touching the lives of over **37,000 patient visits** annually.

For over a quarter of a century, UMMA has been steadfast in its mission to cater to the holistic needs of the communities we serve. **We are more than just a health center; we are a hub of innovation and equity in healthcare**, offering an integrated suite of primary care, behavioral health, and oral health services. Beyond our clinical offerings, **we are trailblazers in health education programming and community engagement**. Initiatives like our pioneering Health on Wheels and Food Security Initiative programs are just a few examples of how we continue to break new ground, ensuring that every individual in South Los Angeles has access to the care they deserve.



UMMA views the social drivers of health (SDOH) as interrelated and our work as part of a larger push toward systemic health equity. The SDOH that UMMA works to address include economic stability, neighborhood and physical environment, education, food security, healthcare, and community safety and social context.

We were conceived as and have functioned as a vehicle to fight against dehumanization and oppression. Our founders consciously chose to locate in South Los Angeles, an area of LA that serves as a cradle for social justice leadership to challenge systemic oppression, while facing the highest levels of economic marginalization and social stigma. **We strive to keep UMMA at the forefront of the social justice landscape fighting for health and justice.**



# HEALTH SERVICES

## UMMA'S HEALTH SERVICES

UMMA Health provides a variety of primary care services, all housed under one roof, making health care accessible for the entire family. Primary care covers everything from non-urgent medical needs and routine check-ups to the screening, diagnosis, and management of acute and chronic conditions, including diabetes, hypertension, and asthma. We prioritize consistent care, focusing on preventive measures like screenings and immunizations, coupled with patient education and lifestyle support, to ensure our community's health and well-being.

## PEDIATRIC CARE

In 2024, we made significant improvements in our pediatric well-child visits, **increasing visits by close to 20%** and thereby reaching an **82% adherence rate** - well above average for health centers. In addition, this focus led to our patients' **childhood immunization rates going up by 8%**! This increase directly correlates to the trust we have built with our patients and in the community overall.

## PRENATAL CARE PROGRAM

At UMMA Health we are proud of our **CenteringPregnancy** program, a group-visit model of care that increases patient engagement, their connection to other pregnant people in the community, their access to prenatal resources, such as our evidence-based Comprehensive Perinatal Services Program (CPSP), and empowers them to take charge of their babies' health. **In 2024, we had 228 prenatal patients and 1,339 prenatal visits, with a total of 98 babies delivered.**







# DENTAL CLINIC

The expansion of dental services and patient access is a priority for UMMA. In South Los Angeles, **1 in 2 adults and 1 in 10 children do not have access to a dentist**, and with our high-quality oral care services we are working to combat these statistics. In 2024, through the support of Representative Lucille Roybal-Allard, and individual donors, UMMA was able to launch our Mobile Dental Clinic, now serving LAUSD schools.

Our dental services include:

- Routine dental check-ups
- Teeth cleaning and fluoride application
- Application of sealants to prevent cavities
- Full mouth treatment for serious decay
- Complete dental treatment
- Dental education

# COMMUNITY PROGRAMS

## FOOD SECURITY INITIATIVE

UMMA has been hosting a Free Food Fair for more than eight years. Every Wednesday at three different school sites, we provide free fresh fruits and vegetables provided by Food Forward. The food is then distributed to local community members and 21 nonprofit organizations who are able to feed their own clients. This past year, we were able to purchase a new truck with the support of Supervisor Mitchell's office. Our new vehicle allowed us to increase the amount of food distributed this year as we can now pick up the food ourselves from Food Forward's warehouse.

## STUDENT HEALTH LEADER PROGRAM

UMMA's Student Health Leader Program empowers high school and college students with the tools, training, and mentorship needed to become community health advocates and future leaders in healthcare. Through hands-on experience in health education, outreach, and public service, students gain real-world exposure to community-based care while supporting wellness initiatives across South Los Angeles. This program strengthens the local workforce pipeline by inspiring the next generation of equity-driven health professionals.





# EXPANSION PROJECTS

## Locke Wellness Center

Early in 2025, UMMA Health will open its third school-based site in partnership with LAUSD at Locke Early Childhood Education Center. Neighboring Watts, this site will provide primary care and dental care, becoming our second dental location.



## Al-Shifa Clinic

In the spring of 2025, Al-Shifa Clinic, a long-standing titan of Islam-inspired care in San Bernadino, will join the UMMA Health network. Founded 25 years ago with similar roots to that of UMMA, our partnership will increase access to medical services.



## Figueroa Care Center

This new site, scheduled to open in early fall of 2025, will operate as UMMA's first urgent care, marking a historic moment in UMMA's history of care to the residents of South LA. Operating as one of our larger sites, this urgent care center will be the first of its kind in South LA, accepting all Medi-Cal plans.

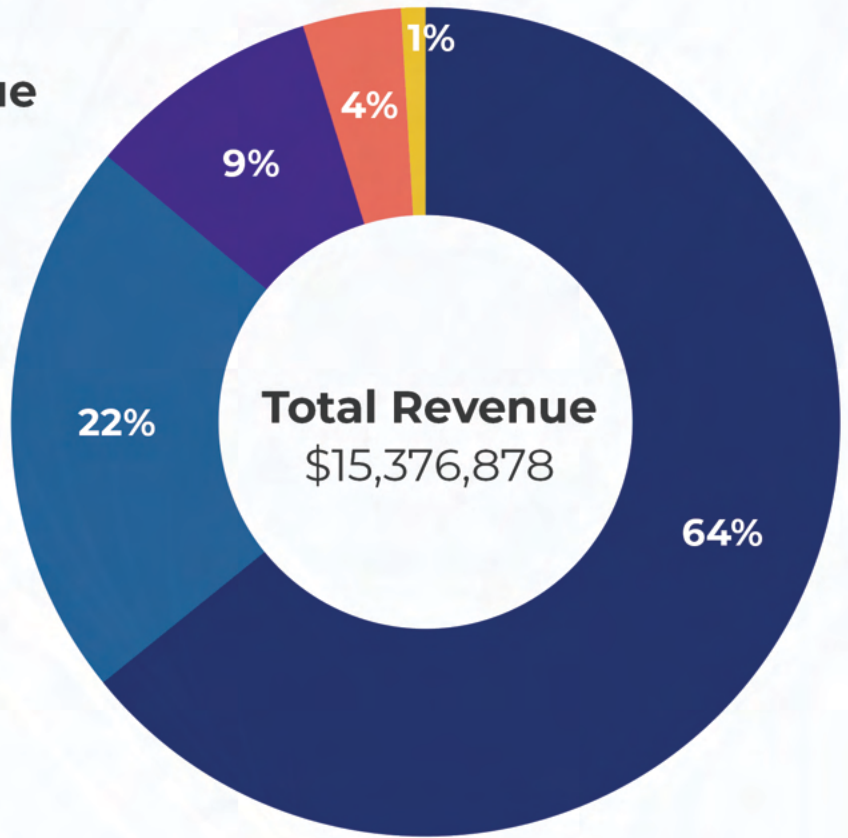
## INDIVIDUAL DONORS

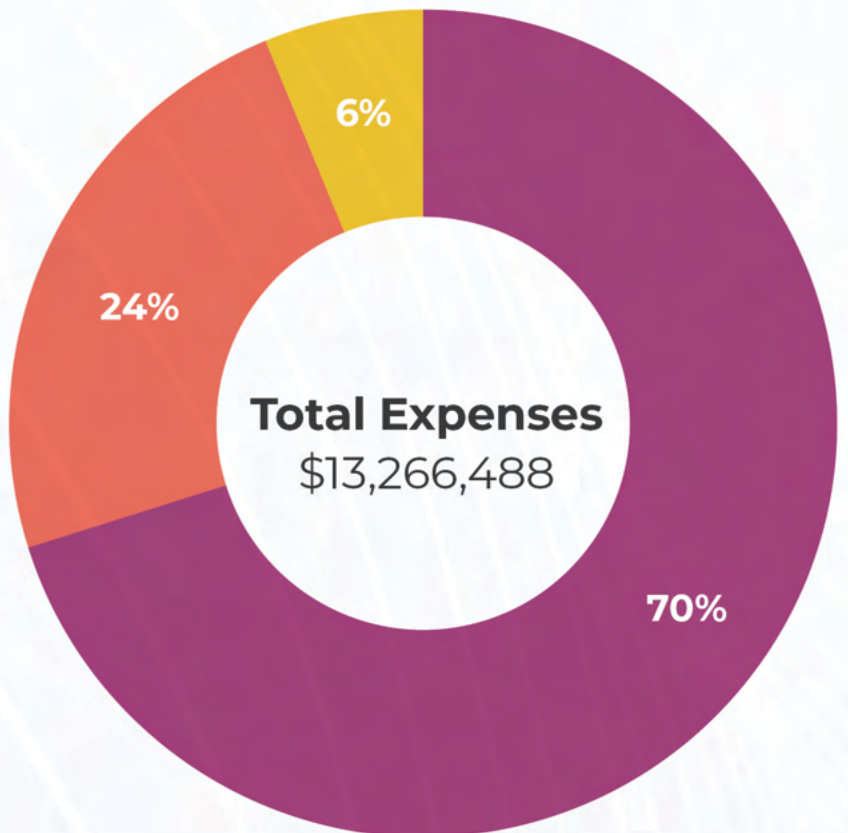
